HISTORY:

EduStream was envisioned by San Bernardino Community College District as a way to provide quality online educational media for faculty and staff to use in their online courses.

EduStream is funded through a five-year renewable grant from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office in partnership with Palomar College.

DESCRIPTION:

EduStream is a digital repository that partners with content vendors to provide quality, ADA compliant educational media for the benefit of faculty, staff, and students.

Faculty and staff are able to link educational media into their course management systems where students are then able to view them during the online course. Learning objects are also available to provide a more interactive learning experience and increased academic rigor.

Some key facts about EduStream:

- 3000+ ADA compliant educational videos
- All proprietary content are captioned
- Free to all California Community Colleges
- Seamless integration into any Course Management System (Blackboard, Moodle, Angel, etc.)
- Four 24/7 live Web-streaming channels (more can be added as needed)
- Ability for Faculty and Staff to upload their own educational content and share with students and other faculty within their respective institutions.
- Faculty and Staff are also able to create an unlimited number of custom playlists which they can add proprietary content or their own self-made content.

SERVICES/PRODUCTS:

24/7 Streaming Channels:

- Offers institutions the ability to post advertisements, stream live events, and webcast faculty lectures as just a few examples.

Digital Repository:

- Faculty and Staff can upload their own digital files into a custom playlist and create links to the content from any learning management system. Each CCC institution is also provided with 100 gigabytes of free space.
- The repository is also setup with a disaster recovery (DR) site located in Phoenix, Arizona. In the event of any unforeseen disasters or downtime, the DR site will continue functionality of EduStream and users will not see an interruption in service.

Videos on Demand:

- SBCCCD is partnered with content vendors to provide professional, ADA compliant educational media free of charge to the CCC.
- There are more than 3,000 media clips and learning objects that faculty and staff can make use of in their courses.

- Centralized digital repository that is free to all CCC colleges.
- Professionally produced and edited content that is captioned for ADA compliance.
- Ability for faculty and staff to provide their own learning materials and be able to share them with other faculty and students.
- Free 24/7 live streaming channels to broadcast live events, advertising, online tutoring, etc., in real time.
