HISTORY:

The project was created in 1998 to provide support for the growing use of technology in the classroom and has expanded to support technology infrastructure. Current plans include expanding the use of the @ONE technical infrastructure to provide professional development for topics other than those that are technology-related.

DESCRIPTION:

The @ONE Project provides training, support, and online resources to California Community Colleges faculty, staff, and IT professionals to enhance student learning and success by using technology.
