HISTORY: The California Community Colleges Technology Center at Butte College is funded by a grant from the CCC Chancellor's Office. The grant began in 1996 as the 4CNet Backbone Upgrade Project with a primary focus on supporting the statewide digital network, 4CNet, now known as CENIC. In 2002, the grant was renewed with added responsibilities and renamed the CCC Technology Center. The grant was renewed again in 2007.

DESCRIPTION: The California Community Colleges Technology Center helps to facilitate and coordinate the work of the CCC systemwide technology projects and partnerships. The Technology Center supports the statewide digital network, CENIC, which serves all 110 CCC campuses.
